### POSTGRADUTE UNIVERSITY DOCTORAL STUDIES

- programs:
  - 1. Management of sustainable development (MOR)
  - 2. Business Economics in Tourism and Hospitality (PETU)
- duration: 3 years, 180 ECTS credits
- full-time and part-time
- academic title: doctor of science in the area of social sciences, field of economics
- abbreviation of academic title: dr. sc.

### **ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

- completed graduate university study according to the principles of the Bologna process, by whose completion at least 300 ECTS-credits were gained and the academic title Master of Economics (mag. oec.) was acquired
- applicants who according to previous regulations have graduated from an appropriate pre-Bologna four-year university study, upon whose completion a university degree in the field of economics has been acquired
- Exceptionally, admission to the doctoral study MOR can be achieved by anyone who completed a graduate university study according to the principles of the Bologna process, (300 ECTS) or a four-year pre-Bologna university study, but not from the field of economics, provided that from the moment of the admission to the doctoral study until the commencement of the classes in the first semester of the first year of study, the exams in the courses "Macroeconomics" and "Microeconomics" have successfully been taken.
- All admission requirements are defined by the <u>Rulebook on postgraduate</u> <u>university studies (doctoral studies)</u> on FTHM decision
