


Creating of Student Account


2. Click on **Submit**




Use for viewing of **Originality report** (Originality report and teachers comments)

Originality report viewing

a) Originality report

1. Click on the Originality bottom.



2. The screen is divided in two parts:

To aid in usability, these catalogs are progressively moving towards further specialization. HW Wilson's Art Full Text is one such niche database. Specializing exclusively in scholarly articles exploring the arts and related subjects, the site is heavily relied upon by students and researchers around the world. By carrying the Wilson name, it is a trustworthy, if occasionally problematic resource. [sample comment]

One of the major [sample comment] with the site is the assumption made by the creators of the Help section that users will have enough significant experience with databases to understand the particular vocabulary of such sites. For example, they advise users not to use "truncation". Many users will have no idea what this means. Still others may drop letters in a search as a matter of course without knowing that this is called truncating. If a user is sufficiently stumped in such searching tactics, it is doubtful they will utilize the help section to begin with. For those that are truly in need, the section will not provide the very aid it purports to impart.

The site offers three basic ways to search, a Basic or Advanced search and a [sample comment]

needs.

The Basic and Advanced search functions operate in a very similar fashion, the main difference being the increased limiters available in the Advanced section. [sample comment]
